Tier 1: Animal Handling

## **HEART Application Process:**

- Fill out the Volunteer Application. Scan and email it, mail it, or bring it to a monthly meeting:
  - o Please check the HEART website to confirm the details of monthly meetings.

- Complete the Spokane County Emergency Management (SCEM) Volunteer Application. The online application can be found here:

## **HEART Requirements:**

- Complete HEART Volunteer Application, including signing liability waiver
- Completed SCEM Volunteer Application and be approved by SCEM to volunteer
- Sign HEART photo release
- Sign a copy of the HEART Rules & Responsibilities
- Complete the following free FEMA courses and submit certificates of completion to HEART:
  - o IS 100.C: Introduction to Incident Command System

  - IS 700.B: National Incident Management System https://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-700.a
- Have a current first aid/CPR certification. Classes available through SCEM, or the following agencies: Medic First Aid, American Heart Association, Red Cross, ASHI, or Evergreen Safety Council.
- Complete the free Blood Borne Pathogens class available through the county (required every 2 years): http://wisha-training.lni.wa.gov/Training/articulate/BBPathogens/story.html
- Attend the HEART Temporary Sheltering class when offered
- Recommend tetanus vaccine
